## Former Member of the Audrain County Court.

Judge Martin C. Flynt, 70 years old, of near Gant, died last Tuesday morning after an illness of about three weeks. He had been a citizen of the county nearly 50 years. Was a soldier in the Confederate army, belonging under Cockrell's Brigade, and served in a number of hard fought battles. He was a high-minded Christian gentleman and an honored Mason. Judge Flynt's wife died about 23 years ago. The following children survive him: Mrs. Edward Faucett, of California; Mrs. T. F. Mildred and Misses Minerva and Laura Flynt and Robert, Spencer, Kennett and Jason Flynt, all of this county. Dr. J. F. Flynt of Molino is a nephew.

The funeral was held yesterday afternoon at Mt. Zion church conducted by Rev. Zehr. Mr. Flynt was a Methodist and a member of Houston Lodge A. F. & A. M. No. 580, at Gant, the burial being with Masonic honors.

We mourn Judge Flynt's death. His passing is a distinct loss to the community. He was our friend and we shall miss him.
