

WHEREAS, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1855, entitled "An Act in addition to certain Acts granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the military service of the United States," there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND, OFFICE acres, in favor of Mary Hunt Warrant No. 6/5-3-6 widow of Richard Flynt, Private, Capt. Housers Co. N. C. Militia, War 1812

with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the South half of the South West quarter and the North East quarter of the South West quarter of Section six in Townships two North of Range Gifteen West of the Fifth Princepal Meridian in Arkansas containing one hundred and six acres and thirty five hundredths of an acre according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND GETTEE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL The Raid warrant having been duly assigned to John N. Holleroft in whose favor Raid tract has been located NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said John & Hollcroft and to his heirs

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said John N. Holleroft and to his

heirs and assigns forever.
