Robert Lee (Bobby) Glover 93 years of age, born April 20, 1931 from Lonoke Arkansas passed away peacefully on March 16, 2025. He was welcomed with open arms in to heaven to a joyous celebration by so many dear family members & loved ones which had passed before him. Bobby previously resided at StoneBridge Assisted Living in Heber Springs AR. For the past year he was so lovingly cared for by members of Arkansas Hospice Care & staff at the facility.

Bobby was born in Eldorado, AR to parents Roy H. Glover Sr (NeeNaw), Lois Fawcett Glover (MawMaw) & older brother Roy H. Glover Jr (HoHo) all whom have preceded him in passing.
