Beard Cemetery

A very small family cemetery about 300 yards north of Arkansas Highway 236, one and one half miles west of intersection of Highway 236 and 31, about 4 miles north of I40 and Lonoke and very near Fairview community.

On a small high spot, maybe 3 or 4 feet higher than surrounding fields. Three north-south rows of graves

I got excited at seeing the name Clayton which runs thru and connects the Beard and Flynt families, and did not get a good photo of this momument.

AND many other surnames common to Prairie/Lonoke County area. Leaning on back of Richard M Flynt is a broken marker, lamb on top

Mildred Flynt

Oct 15, 1853 Dec 19, 1932

This marker was moved from Wattensaw Cemetery where Mildred Flynt is buried. She is not buried in Beard. She was second wife of Richard M Flynt, and sister of his first wife Susan Thomason. It is possible that Susan Thomason Flynt and Stephen Clayton Flynt could be buried in Beard Cemetery. There appears to be adequate space between the graves of Richard M Flynt and John Clayton Beard for 3 to 5 unmarked graves.
