Returns for 1803 show paid Jas. Watkins for:

chambric gloves, pink shawl, etc. for Miss Ann Freeman

Receipt of L. Wilson Petersburg 12/12/1803 saddle & bridle for Miss Ann Freeman. Paid for provisions, cash for the

Widow-Sarah Freeman. The negro Sally is dead.

John Freeman administrator of William Freeman dec'd sold 575 acres in Oglethorpe Co. and 400 in Wilkes and Lot#2 in Augusta 9/24/1796.

William Freeman of Richmond Co. deed to Dunkin Bohannon of Wilkes Co. Holman Freeman test 9/15/1787

p. 4 Deed Book DD 1788-1789

Minutes of Inferior Court 1801-12: 3/14/1802 Holman Freeman asking for free title to 800 acres where he now lives bond for which given by William Freeman in his lifetime-dec'd.

Holman Freeman came from VA with his wife, 2 sons, and 3 daughters between ages of 12 & 20. Early records GA-Davidson

Hannah Joplings father George Freeman named in his will sons: George, John, Joseph, and Holman who moved to Wilkes Co., GA.

Henrico County, VA Deeds & Wills 1725-1737

George Freeman lists wfe: Jane Freeman, sons: Holman & George Freeman as executors.
