Will of Halstin Flynt

In the name of God Amen. the **twentysixth day of August 1804**. -- I **Hastin Flynt** being sick in body but of good and perfect memory thanks be to almighty God. And calling to remembrances the uncertain state of this transitory life and that all flesh must yeld unto death when it shall please God to call. do make constitute ordain & declare this my last will & testament in manner and form following,

My body to be buried in such a place as may please my exceutor hereafter named to appoint. I now for the settling my corporal estate and such goods and chattles and debts as it hath pleased God far above my deserts to bestow upon me.

I do order give and dispose the same in manner and form following.

That is to say first I will that all those debts and dues which I owe in right or conscience to any manner of person or persons whatsoever shall be will and truly contisted? and paid as ordained to be paid within convenial time after my decease by my executors hereafter named.

Item. I bequeath to my dear **wife Mary Flynt** my real & personal estate to be at her disposal for the maintainance & raising of **these children** during life or widowhood excepting such property as the executors may see cause to dispose of.

Item. And if my wife after my decease should see proper to marry that a third part of my goods & chattles be hers during life the remaining part to come into the executors hands to be equally appropoiated to the use of **the childred as they come of age**.

I appoint my friends to execute this my last will & testament **Mary Flynt, David Flynt, & Martin Flynt**.
