in the Town of Paris on the last Monday
of June 1837 a regular Term of the Hon.
County Court pertaining to the Estates
of Deceased persons Present and
Presiding John H. Crook Chief
Justice, Cortez R. Roland Sheriff of
Samuel County, and Jacob Long Clerk
of the County Court of said Samuel County
the Court having been Opened by the
Sheriff the proceedings were had to
wit -

J. D. A. Walker Application
of Guardian
of Albert A. Williams minor
Heir of S. E. Williams Dec'd

And now comes into open
Court the said Albert A. Williams minor
Heir of S. E. Williams Dec'd, or the
age of 14 years, and made choice of
the said J. D. A. Walker as his Guar-
-dian, Whereupon the Court appointed
the said J. D. A. Walker Guardian of
the said Albert A. Williams, and thereup-
-on the said J. D. A. Walker put into
bond in the sum of One thousand doll-
-ars with Cortez R. Roland, and J. V.
-more as securities for the faithful per-
-formance of his duties as Guardian aforesaid
and took the Oath required by the Statute
after which letters of Guardianship to
said Walker -

Which Bond is in words & figures as
follows to wit -

The State of Texas,
County of Samar,
Know all men by these presents that we J. D. Walker as principal and Cortez R. Roland and Linn V. Moore, as writers, are held and firmly bound unto the Chief Justice of the County of Samar, in the sum of One thousand dollars, for the payment of which well and truly to be made unto the said Chief Justice we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents signed with our hands, and sealed with our seals the seals being several, the 29th day of June A.D. 1857. The condition of this obligation is such that whereas the above bound J. D. Walker has been appointed Guardian of Albert A. Williams minor Heir of Sterling C. Williams deceased. Now if the said J. D. Walker shall well and truly perform all the duties required of him under said appointment, then this obligation shall be null and void otherwise to remain of full force and effect.
