(He was 2nd son of Edward Lloyd II - after E. LL II's death, Sarah married Col James Hollyday & built Readbourne in Queen Anne County. They lived at Wye until her son, Edward III came of age. As oldest surviving son of Hon Col Lloyd, this Philemon was for nearly 11 years the owner of Wye House but dying just under age, it passed to his brother, another Edward Lloyd III.)

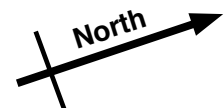
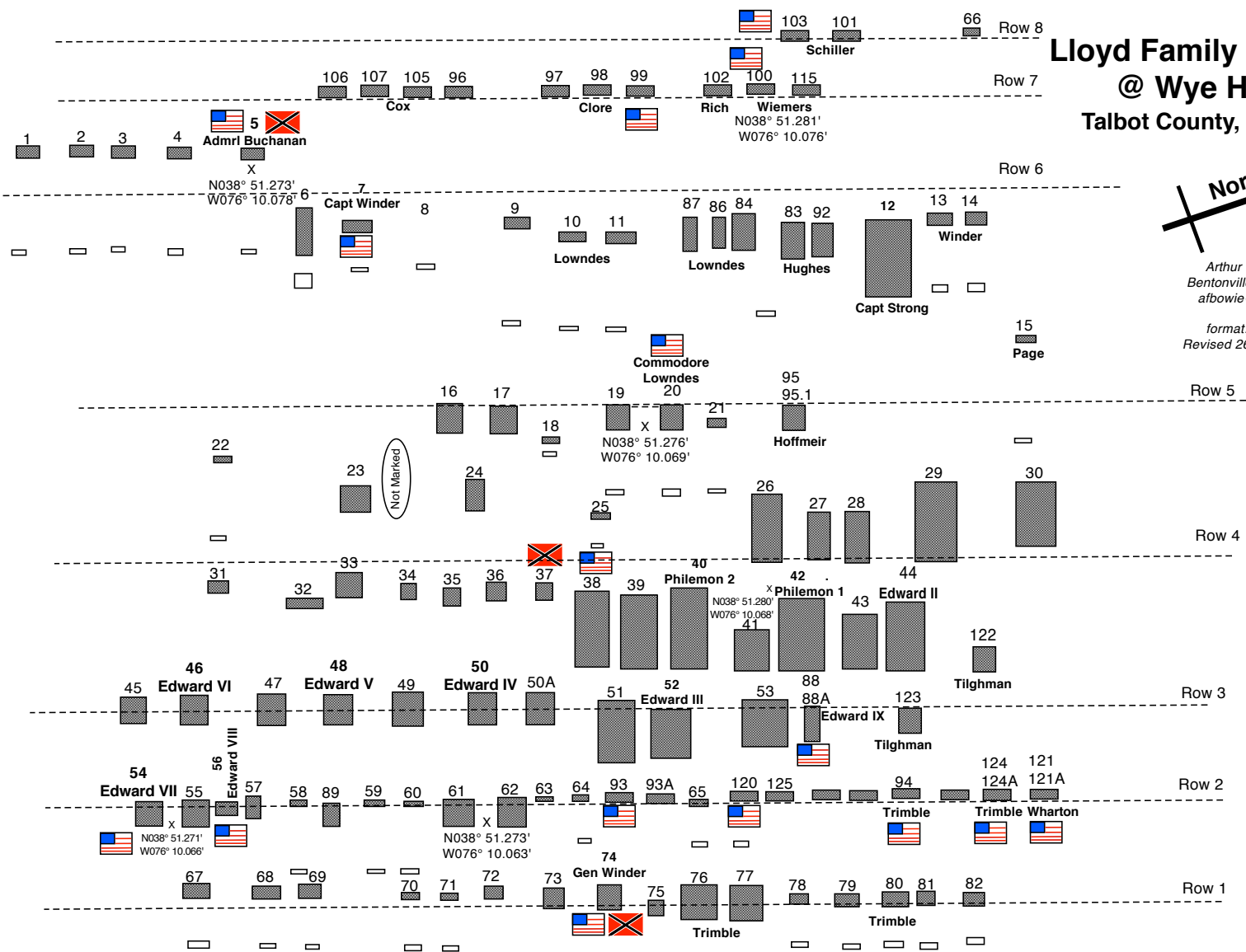
